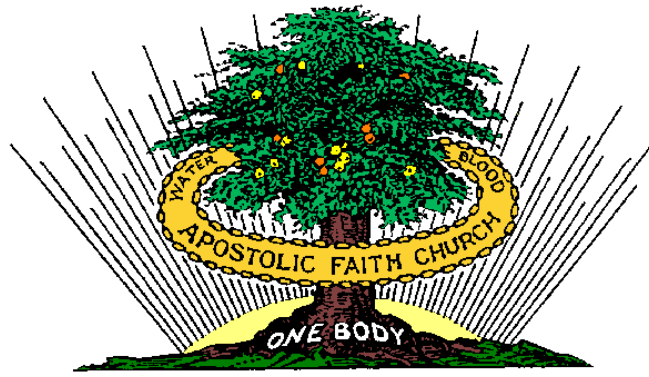

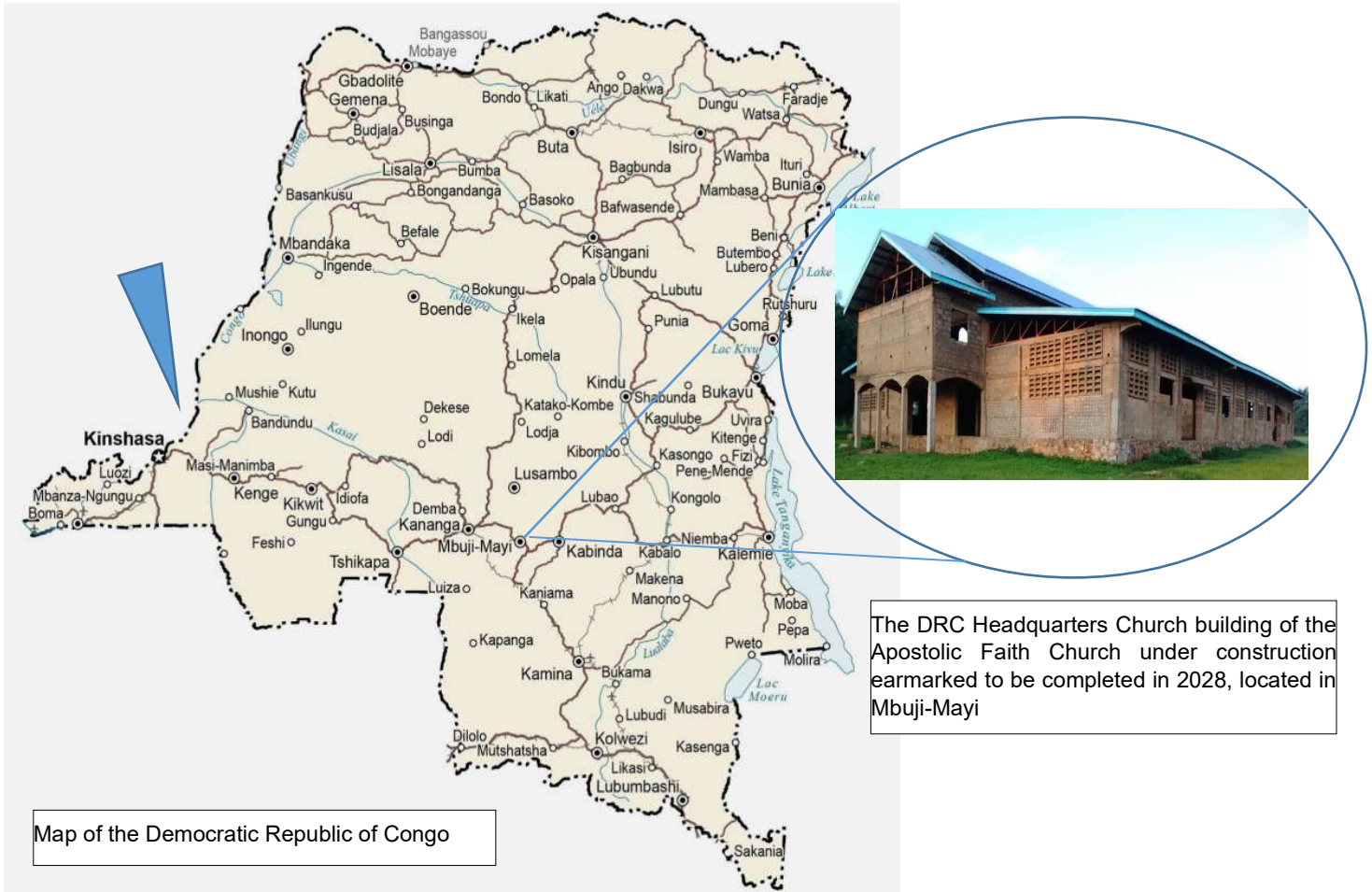

Regional Overseer – North Visits DRC Kinshasa During Passover Conference

The Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) is a vast country in Central Africa which falls among the Apostolic Faith Church territories under the North of Limpopo Region presided over by the Regional Overseer – North Rev. Noah Msimanga whereas the DRC Country Overseer is Rev. Deiudonne Kabongo. The capital city of DRC is in Kinshasa while the country headquarters for the Apostolic Faith Church is situated in Mbuji-Mayi. However, the AFC has six branches in Kinshasa District where Rev Noah Msimanga visited during the Passover Conference, which was held from 1st to 5th April 2026 at Bethanie branch.

The Regional Overseer - North was accompanied by his wife Deaconess Eunice Msimanga and they arrived in DRC Kinshasa early on 30th March 2026, a few days before the commencement of the conference, which gave him an opportunity to visit some local church branches within the city.

The AFC has 6 local churches within Kinshasa which the Regional Overseer – North visited, namely Philadelphia, Rehoboth, Bethsaida, Bon-novel, Ebenezer, and Bethania which was the venue for the Passover conference and headed by Rev Joachim, the District Overseer for Kinshasa.

The message of the conference was centered on God's plan of redemption through the suffering of Jesus Christ and his humility and obedience unto the Cross of Calvary, by His death and glorious resurrection, having laid down His life for humanity to take away the sin of the world and reconciling the world unto God.

For he was wounded for our transgressions and bruised for our iniquities, that we might receive the forgiveness of sins and be justified unto salvation (Romans 5:1).

The beloved faithful were blessed by the Word and expressed how privileged and overjoyed they were to have the honour of welcoming the Regional Overseer North Rev. Noah Msimanga, who further gave a teaching on leadership and administration of the Church, charging the leaders and members to study, apply and make reference to the AFC Governance, Administration and Management Manual of the Church, emphasizing that if leaders did so, they would find the Governance Manual very helpful and it provides clear understanding of the beginnings and foundation of the Apostolic Faith Church, its Vision, Mission and Objectives, and guides on both the church administration and matters spiritual, as it also contains the Doctrine of the Apostolic Faith Church as given through Revelation in the beginning to our Founding Father Rev. William Oliver Hutchinson. The Regional Overseer also encouraged the beloved Country Overseer Rev. Dieudonne Kabongo for DRC to speed-up and conclude the translation of the AFC Governance Manual into French and distribute to all starting with our District Overseers and Pastors and all leaders in DRC for guidance and alignment.

Further, Rev Msimanga also presented an opportunity for the saints to honour our Father in the Lord and late International Chief Overseer Rev. Duncan Lee and lifting up before the Lord and upholding our Mother Mrs Lee before the Throne for comfort and strength, knowing that her sons and daughters in thousands around the world are praying for her. He further presented the news of the appointment of the new International Chief Overseer before the saints and the Country Overseer Rev. Kabongo reports that the whole congregation received the news with joy calling upon the Lord for His grace for the days ahead.

Overall around 400 believers were in attendance noting that this was a conference mainly attended by Kinshasa District only while other Districts held separate conferences due to the vastness of the country but also a historically difficult transport network in a country that has seen too many civil and rebel wars. Currently the eastern part of the country is at war with some parts of the eastern provinces under the control of rebel groups. As we pray for the nations, let's uphold the DRC before the Throne of God for the Lord's intervention for peace to prevail by His grace, that the people of God especially the vulnerable women and children will be protected and that the hearts of men, the leaders and politicians shall turn to God.

Praise the Lord that the suffering of our Lord Jesus Christ on the Cross was not defeat but divine victory. It accomplished redemption, healing, deliverance, empowerment and Salvation through the Blood.
