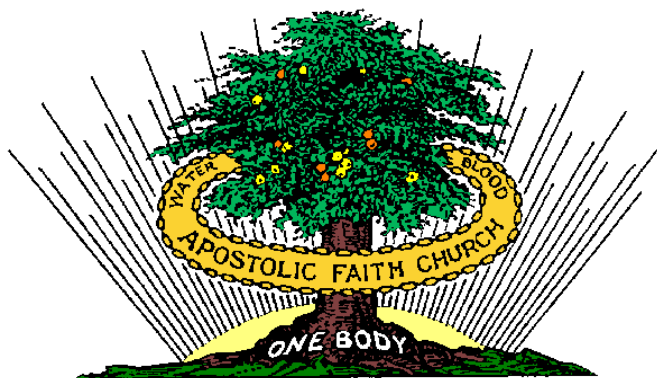

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The Gathering of the Saints: The Namibia Passover Conference

“But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement {*punishment*} for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed ... He was led as a lamb to the slaughter, And as a sheep before its shearers is silent, So He opened not His mouth” (Isaiah 53:5; 7 NKJV). Oh what a privilege! Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the children of God! (1 John 3:1); all because Christ was faithful and laid down His life for us. Scripture says, “...God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us” (Roman 5:8). For “There is no greater love than to lay down one’s life for one’s friends” (John 15:13 NLT).

What a Blessing ... that by His Blood, we are set free from bondage, forgiven of sin, and have been justified! Hallelujah to the Lamb of God! Jesus Christ is the Passover Lamb. And that is the reason why we gather as saints for the Passover celebration.

The General Secretary for Namibia, Pastor Moses Matyayi, reports that the Annual Passover Conference of 2026 was successfully convened in Namibia from 2nd to 4th April 2026 at the Sauyemwa Centre, in Kavango West District, bringing together slightly over 1,000 faithful delegates from multiple districts across the country in fellowship to celebrate the Passover lamb who shed His Blood on the cross that we may live. Core messages were anchored on the biblical foundation and purpose of the Passover while sharing on the theme of the year: Walking in Divine Wisdom, Revelation Knowledge, and Understanding according to 1 Colossians 1:9-14. The faithful were called upon to walk worthy in exemplary Christian conduct and self-examination, in unity, in communion and love in Christ Jesus.

Rev. Petrus Malungu, the District Overseer for Khomas, presided and officially opened the conference. He shared a message with the congregation on the purpose of the Passover from the book of Exodus 12:22–23, as God instructed Moses: “Take a bunch of hyssop, dip it into the blood in the basin and put some of the blood on the top and on both sides of the doorframe ... When the Lord goes through the land to strike down the Egyptians, he will see the blood ... and will PASSOVER that doorway.” This was the first PASSOVER. Here we see the power and protection of the Blood, as the people of Israel were spared not by their own strength or that they were perfect, but because of the Blood of the Lamb that marked them as belonging to God.


Just as Israel was saved by the blood on their doorposts, we are saved through the blood of Christ, the Lamb of God. But there is a progression we must not miss. We are now covered and marked, not physically on our door-posts, but spiritually in our hearts by the Blood of Christ. Therefore, walk in the identity God has given you in Christ. For we, like Jacob, have been given a new name; we have been changed and transformed. Like Israel, we have been preserved unto the Lord. And through Christ, we have been redeemed forever. Glory to God.

Pastor Moses George Nalisa, the District Overseer for Zambezi East, shared a message on Walking in Divine Wisdom, Revelation Knowledge and Understanding. He said Divine wisdom is not the philosophical understanding of men, or the intellectual wisdom from textbooks, or that which is acquired by being long-serving members of the church, but this is the Wisdom from God, not of this world, but that given by the Holy Spirit. "But the natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; nor can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned" (1 Corinthians 2:14, NKJV).

We therefore walk in spiritual discernment, not according to the influence of the traditional cultures and politics, not according to the wisdom of perversion from the evil spirit of darkness and demonic powers that prophesy lies and deception. But we are enlightened by the Revelation of the Word in the Spirit of Light. "But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, the hidden wisdom which God ordained before the ages for our glory, which none of the rulers of this age knew" (1 Corinthians 2:7). Therefore, we must have the understanding that it is the Holy Spirit that leads us in Divine Wisdom through Revelation Knowledge by the Word of the Lord.

For this reason, we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding (1 Colossians 1:9, NKJV).
