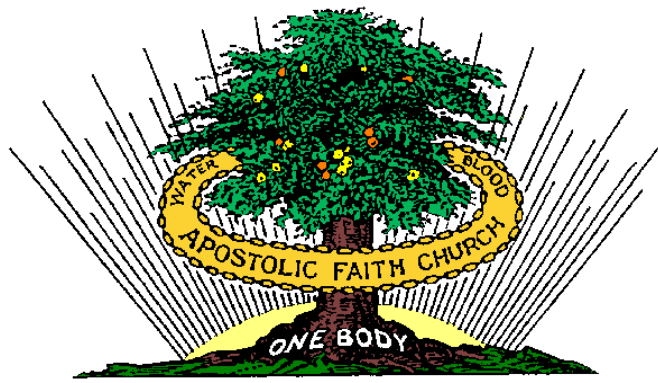

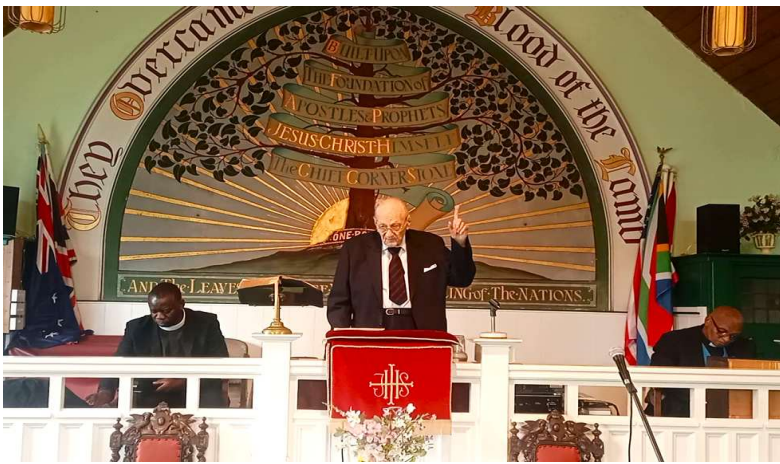

## Ordination Of Regional Overseer

### **Regional Overseer – South Of Limpopo Officially Ordained and Consecrated into Office at the International Headquarters Church in Bournemouth**



Rev. Duncan Lee, the International Chief Overseer of the Apostolic Faith Church assisted by the Deputy International Chief Overseer Rev Jeremiah Sande officially ordained and consecrated into office Rev Hercules M. Khumalo as the Regional Overseer for the South of Limpopo region of the Apostolic Faith Church. The installation service took place at the International Headquarters Church in Bournemouth, England during a special service on 13<sup>th</sup> October 2024.

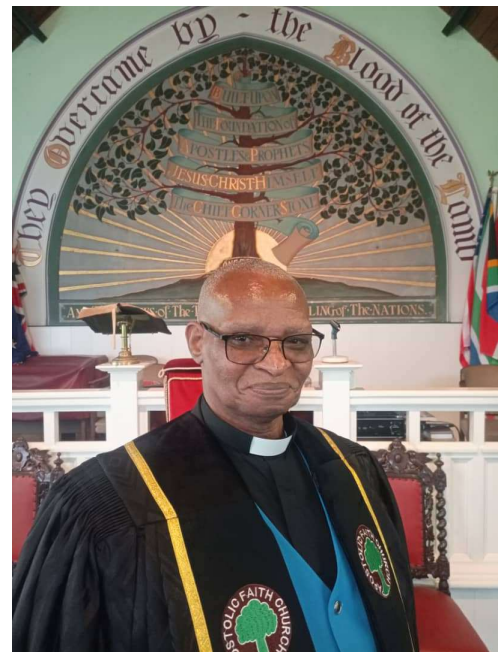
The ordination was a confirmation of the appointment of Rev HM Khumalo as the Regional Overseer – South of Limpopo that was announced on 4<sup>th</sup> June 2024 after the dismissal of the former National Overseer – South of Limpopo PM Sebotsa who was tempted and when given an opportunity to resolve the matters in love chose to rebel against the Lord and the Apostolic Order of the Root Church. The Office of Regional Overseer replaces that of National Overseer as guided under the AFC Governance Manual issued in 2018.

It pleased the Apostolic leadership of the Church at the Root that God through the Holy Spirit called Rev Hercules Khumalo to serve His people in the High Office of Regional Overseer – South of Limpopo. It is a blessing that after much consideration and prayer under the seemingly difficult circumstances, Rev Khumalo said yes to the Lord's calling to serve God's people, asking the Lord to do His will.

The International Chief Overseer under the unction of the Holy Spirit Anointing Rev Khumalo said “I Anoint you in the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ and in the Power of the Precious Shed Blood of the Lamb, the Word of the Lord shall rest upon thee, the Word of the Lord shall guide thee. In the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ receive thou the Blessing of the Lord,” and the Holy Spirit through the Servant of the Lord spoke saying “Be thou strengthened and rejoice in that knowledge, for the Word of the Lord shall flow unto thee, and I shall speak it fourth in many nations in the Southlands and in the northern territories. My Word shall flow through thy mouth, because I have anointed it to be so, saith the Lord.” And he declared “the Lord bless thee and keep thee, may the light of His countenance shine upon thee, may he give you peace, in the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ, Amen”.

### **After God’s Own Heart**

The consecration message of the Chief Overseer’s Office is that God is seeking for those After Gods’ Own Heart to serve Him and His people. In the book of 1 Samuel 13:8-14, the Bible gives an account of Saul when he disobeyed God and did not follow the Instruction and Order of the Lord through the Servant of the Lord Prophet Samuel and the Samuel addressed Saul and asked “what is this that you have done?” Samuel continued and told Saul that his Kingdom would no longer continue because Saul did not obey the commandment of the Lord, saying in verse 14 that now “...the LORD hath sought Himself a man AFTER HIS OWN HEART, and the LORD hath commanded him to be captain over His people...” In the book of Jeremiah 3:15 the LORD declares – “And I will give you shepherds after my own heart, who will feed you with knowledge and understanding”.

abroad, as sheep having no shepherd. “God expects us to be move with compassion for His people and bring all those scattered abroad back in the House of the Lord. He also read from Romans 16:17 which admonishes leaders saying “...mark them which cause divisions and offences contrary to the doctrine which you have learned; and avoid them. For they that are such serve not our Lord Jesus Christ, but their own belly; and by good words and fair speeches deceive the hearts of the simple.”

The Deputy ICO in his message during the service said leaders must seek after God’s heart and their motive must be to serve God and His people, of whom the Lord Jesus Christ paid a price by His Blood and has charged those in leadership to feed His flock with knowledge and Understanding, rather than focus on themselves and their selfish interests. He further made reference to Mathew 9:36 to 38 which says of the Lord Jesus that “...when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered
